

Miss Bear as Harvest Angel Crochet Pattern

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MATERIALS NEEDED:

300 yds Maize, size 7 crochet hook, needle large enough to take thread, 2 snaps, glue, Embroidery needles, Bucilla brand silk embroidery ribbon in #638 Parrot Green (3 yds), #511 Sunset (3 yds), #655 Light Yellow (3 yds), and #502 Maize (3 yds).

Gauge: 9 sc = 1", 10 sc rows = 1", 9 dc = 1", 5 dc rows = 1".

DRESS:

ROW 1: With maize thread and size 7 hook ch-39, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (38 sts)

ROW 2: Sc ea st across, ch-1, turn.

ROW 3: Sc next 7 sts, 2 sc next st, sc across to last 8 sts, 2 sc next st, sc next 7 sts, ch-1, turn. (40 sts)

ROW 4: Rep row 2.

ROW 5: Rep row 3. (42 sts)

ROW 6: Rep row 2.

ROW 7: Rep row 3. (44 sts)

ROW 8: Rep row 2.

ROW 9: Rep row 3. (46 sts)

ROW 10: Rep row 2.

ROW 11: Sc next 18 sts, hdc next st, 2 dc next 3 sts, sc next 2 sts, 2 dc next 3 sts, hdc next st, sc next 18 sts, ch-1, turn. (52 sts)

ROW 12: Sc next 7 sts, ch-14, sk next 6 sts, sc next 5 sts, hdc next st, 2 dc next 6 sts sc next 2 sts, 2 dc next 6 sts, hdc next st, sc next 5 sts, ch-14, sk next 6 sts, sc next 7 sts, ch-1, turn, (78 sts + ch)

ROW 13: Sc next 27 sts and ch, (dc dec next 2 sts) 6 times, sl st next 2 sts, (dc dec next 2 sts) 6 times, sc next 27 sts and ch, ch-1, turn. (64 sts)

ROW 14: Sc next 5 sts, 4 st dc cl next 4 sts, sc next 10 sts, 4 st dc cl next 4 sts, sc next 2 sts, (sc dec next 2 sts) 4 times, fasten off. (23 sts)

ROW 15: Join in 1st st of row 14, ch-1, sc same st as ch-1, sc next 3 sts, dc cl next 4 sts, sc next 7 sts, dc cl next 4 sts, sl st next st, turn. (13 sts)

ROW 16: Sl st next st, sc next 5 sts, sc dec next 2 sts, sc next 4 sts, ch-1, turn. (10 sts)

ROW 17: Sc next 8 sts, sl st next st, turn. (8 sts)

ROW 18: Sl st next st, sc next 7 sts, fasten off. (7 sts.)

ROW 19-23: Rep row 14-18 joining end of row 13.

BODICE RUFFLE:

ROW 1: Join maize last ch bottom foundation row of bodice, ch-1, sc same st as ch-1, sc next st, (2 sc next st, sc next 3 sts, across, ch-1, turn. (47 sts)

ROW 2: Sc ea st across, ch-2, turn.

ROW 3: Hdc next 2 sts, (2 hdc next st, hdc next 3 sts) across, ch-3, turn. (58 sts)

ROW 4: Dc next 2 sts, (2 dc next st, dc next 4 sts) across, ch-3, turn. (70 sts)

RND 5: (2 dc next st, dc next 2 sts) across, overlap last 2 sts with 1st 2 sts of rnd, sl st through both thickness, ch-3, turn. (91 sts) YOU ARE NOW WORKING IN RND.

RND 6: (2 dc next st, dc next 4 sts) around, sl st top beg ch-3, turn. (109 sts)

RND 7-8: Dc ea st around, ch-3, turn. At then end of rnd 8 fasten off.

ROW 9: Count over 33 sts from join, join that st, ch-3, dc next 65 sts, leaving the rest of the sts unworked, ch-3, turn. (66 sts)

ROW 10: Dc dec next 2 sts, dc ea st across to last 2 sts, dc dec, ch-3, turn. (64 sts)

ROW 11-19: Rep row 10. At the end of row 19 (46 sts)

TRIM RND: *ch-3, sc next st, ch-4, sc next st, rep from * around working in ea st and end of rows around, sl st base of beg ch-3, fasten off.

SKIRT:

ROW 1: With maize thread and 7 hook ch-43, sc 2nd ch from hook, sc ea ch across, ch-1, turn. (42 sts)

ROW 2: Sc next 2 sts, (2 sc next st, sc next 3 sts) across, ch-2, turn. (52 sts)

ROW 3: Hdc next st, (2 hdc next st, hdc next 4 sts) across, ch-3, turn. (62 sts)

ROW 4: Dc ea st across, ch-3, turn.

ROW 5: Dc next st, (2 dc next st, dc next 4 sts) across, ch-3, turn. (74 sts)

RND 6: Sl st last st of row 5 overlapping it with the 1st st of row 5, YOU ARE NOW WORKING IN RNDs, Ch-3, dc ea st around, sl st top beg ch-3, ch-3, turn. (72 sts)

RND 7-18: Dc ea st around, sl st top beg ch-3, ch-3, turn.

RND 19: Dc next 14 sts, 2 dc next 42 sts, dc last 15 sts, sl st top beg ch-3, ch-3, turn. (114 sts)

RND 20: Dc next 14 sts, (dc next st, 2 dc next st) 42 times, dc next 15 sts, sl st top beg ch-3, fasten off. (156 sts)

ROW 21: Count over 15 sts from join, join that st, ch-3, dc same st as ch-3, 2 dc next 29 sts, leaving the rest of the sts unworked, ch-3, turn. (60 sts)

ROW 22: (2 dc next st, dc next st) across, ch-3, turn. (90 sts)

TRIM RND: *Sc next st, ch-4, sc next st, ch-3, rep from * around entire piece working it in the sides of sts as you go from row 22 to row 20, end by sl st in base of be ch-3, fasten off.

Sew or glue a snap at waist in back.

With needle and silk ribbon, make white twist roses in the shape of a diamond in the center front of skirt, going dark to light and using photo as a guide. Accent with green ribbon seed sts around roses for leaves.

SLEEVES:

RND 1: Join maize thread in 3rd sc of underarm, ch-1, sc next 3 sts, hdc next, (dc next 2 dc next) 7 times, hdc next, sc next 3, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (30 sts)

RND 2-3: Sc ea sc, hdc ea hdc, dc ea dc, around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

RND 4: Sc next 3 sts, hdc next st, (hdc dec next 2 sts, hdc next st) 7 times, hdc next st, sc next 3 sts, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn. (22 sts)

RND 5-7: Sc ea st around, sl st top beg sc, ch-1, turn.

RND 8: *Ch-3, sc next st, ch-4, sc next st, rep from * around , sl st in bottom beg ch-3, fasten off.

Rep for other sleeve\side.

Ch = Chain

St = Stitch

Sl St = Slip Stitch

Sc = Single Crochet

Hdc = Half Double Crochet

Dc = Double Crochet

Dc Cl = Double Cluster Stitch

Bk Lp = Back Loop

Dec = Decrease

Rnd = Round

Beg = Beginning

Rep = Repeat

Bet = Between

Ea = Each

Tog = Together

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
